## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

### What Jesus' Baptism Means For us Today



Today we close out the Christmas season with the Baptism of the Lord in the Jordan and the beginning of the public ministry of Jesus. That Jesus is baptized is significant since it shows that Baptism is the sacrament that enables each of us to live out our faith in the world. Imagine if every Catholic Christian realized the potential of Baptism. What an awesome world we would live in.

Imagine if we lived as closely as the early Christians did even when they were under persecution. No one would be left alone or poor or abandoned. We struggle every day to achieve that Christian perfection but it can be elusive because of our selfishness. Today's feast is a reminder that we can still make the difference in the world.

I am grateful for all the ministers, volunteers and active parishioners who not only worship on Sunday but also give of their time, talent and treasure to build up our parish. I think we have many strengths with our CCD or religious education program and the catechists and parents who work with our children. We have a vibrant young adult group that is always welcoming new people. Look at the full winter and spring schedule on p. 6 of this bulletin. We have the Book Buddies who work year round. All our ministers of the Word and Eucharist. Our LGBT group helps people reconnect to the church and their faith. The

But there are needs that can be done if more people step forward.

- + Are parishioners willing to work with teens and provide support?
- + It would be nice to have more socials so people can party and dance and get to know each other.
- + Is there a need for a divorce and remarried support group?

Can you think of some programs we can initiate? We can do this if more people act on their Baptism and step forward and say, "I can help." That's what Jesus' Baptism means. That we can live out our commitment to the community and make it better.

Tal vez, nos preguntamos porque la fiesta del Bautismo del Señor es el fin del tiempo de Navidad? Cuando Jesus es bautizado, tiene como 30 años, y su infancia es una cosa del pasado distante. Como es, que este evento cabe con los eventos alrededor de su nacimiento? Es una buena pregunta, porque nos lleva en contacto con la realidad al meollo de este tiempo.

Es importante, mientras llegamos al fin del tiempo de la Navidad, que reconozcamos que no es simplemente una ocasión para reflexionar sobre una cosa bonita que pasó hace 2,000 años.
