The NiteFest was perhaps the best ever with great weather attracting so many to enjoy our home-cooked food from Bernadette's Café and the Christian Mothers Spanish Food from St. Joseph. Our DJ Tim Nelson plays great music and the Biergarten was quenching thirsty souls. We had the best bar sales ever for NiteFest. Our Tricky Trays were selling tickets like hot cakes. And the money wheel was spinning constantly. The newest attraction was the CornHole competition, which attracted a score of couples to compete for the a big cash prize of \$300. Dr. Thomas Coughlin and Villanova Matt Coscia were the big winners and were even bigger winners when they donated \$100 of their winnings back to the church. MISSION APPEAL

This weekend at all the Masses, Fr. Jose Estollos will speak for our annual mission appeal, designated by Cardinal Tobin.

He works with the "POOR HELPING THE POOR" program of The Lamb Shall Lead



international and is designed to respond to the poor's problem of survival and spiritual mediocrity and dryness. He will share their mission work on the plight of the poor in the Philippines and on how they are able to help the poor to help themselves. He will also share his experience of abject hunger and poverty of the children and their families, who for three days have no meals to eat, with no homes and shelter (living on the streets) and who die from simple, curable diseases such as measles and broncho-pneumonia. These are heart-breaking realities of misery. The purpose of this appeal will be for: 1) the nutrition and education of the poor children (those considered "scavengers" and street children), 2) the "relocatees" (those who were driven out from along the railroad tracks), 3) the elderly who are chronically ill, 4) the relief and rehabilitation of lives and properties affected by natural disasters, 5) for healing missions in rural areas which include surgical, optical, dental and medical services, 6) for the establishment of daycare and training centers, 7) for the income generating sustainable livelihood, with financial literacy and savings projects to augment the poor's meager income, and 8) spiritual formation of lay leaders and of the young people to become evangelizers of faith, hope and love particularly to their fellow poor. We are all called to contribute and participate to the mission of Jesus, The Lamb, for the least of His brethren. We are all blessed and He will continue to bless us. If you were not prepared to donate this weekend, you may put your donation in an envelope and write, MISSIONARY, on it and deposit it in the collection next weekend.
