

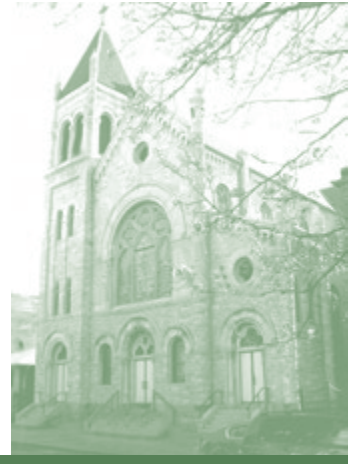

MENSAJE SEMANAL



De las diez virgenes encargadas de mantener las lámparas encendidas para esperar al novio, cinco fueron lo suficientemente prudentes como para disponer lo que necesitaban para la espera. Tomaron consigo suficiente aceite

para encender sus lámparas así estarían preparadas aunque el novio llegase a la medianoche. Las otras cinco no pensaron, no se preocuparon; y la llegada del novio las pilló desprevenidas; así es que se quedaron fuera de la fiesta. Dentro estaba la luz, fuera la oscuridad. La actitud de las que tenían aceite parece egoísta; pero, si se entiende que la luz es la vida espiritual y que el aceite representa las obras del espíritu, en realidad nadie puede dar eso a los demás. Es una actitud interna que no se improvisa.

Hay personas que dejan siempre para mañana lo que pueden hacer hoy. Son personas que están muy seguras de que van a disponer de mañana para reconciliarse con su hermano, visitar a aquel amigo enfermo, devolver lo que robaron, comenzar a ser honestos en el trabajo o preocuparse más de sus hijos. Se olvidan de que el mañana es aquello de lo que ciertamente no estamos seguros. Lo que tenemos como seguro es el ahora, el presente; nada más. ¿No será mejor comenzar a hacer esas cosas ya? Así, en caso de que no dispongamos de mañana, al menos habremos comenzado una vida más feliz; habremos hecho más felices a los de nuestro alrededor; y dejaremos nuestro trabajo mejor hecho. Al menos, podremos decirle al Señor que quizá no terminamos de hacer lo propuesto, pero no fue por no intentarlo. Esto es lo que nos pide Jesús; estar atentos y despiertos en nuestra vida; y hacer lo debido para que, cuando llegue el momento, no estemos sin aceite en las lámparas y con las manos vacías.
