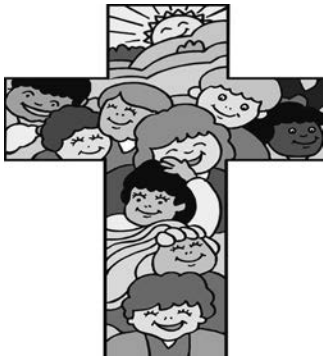

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Our Religious Education Team



In Angela Maffei's absence, due to illness, we have an interim team to run our Religious Education Program, also known as CCD, which begins next Sunday, September 15, 2019, at 9 AM in the School Hall on the corner of 5th & Willow.

At St Joseph, the program is held at 11 AM in the Rectory.

Fr. Phil is the Spiritual Director and Moderator. At OLG, Donna Zukowski, last year's First Communion catechist or teacher, is the Director. Judith Sanchez is the Coordinator. Patrick Giandolfo is the secretary. At St. Joseph, Socorro Martinez, Ellie Millet and Melissa Martinez are the coordinators and catechists. All are parishioners and are involved in the life of the parish.

Passing on the faith is the way the first Christian and then Catholic church started its tradition, which means to hand down. We learn about what our faith teaches and its prayers but most importantly how to join with other Catholics in com-

munity known as the Mass or Eucharist. This is why we hold our instruction on Sunday mornings. It is important to come to church every Sunday or Saturday evening, an obligation for all Catholics.

We will offer catechism from Kindergarten through Eight Grades. To make First Communion and Confirmation, there is a two-year preparation regardless of the child's age. It is also important to attend in between those Sacraments so the children learn about the faith as they get older.

At OLG, beginning September 22, all instruction will take place in the Parish Center at 411 Clinton St. Parents will be able to wait in a space in the center or come back at 10:15 to retrieve children. We will keep attendance and it is important to be present every Sunday we are in session. The first session will be in the School Hall and the program and changes will be explained.

We are happy for our catechists and those who came forward to assist. All are volunteers and love our faith and care for the children. If you have any questions, please call Patrick Giandolfo Monday through Thursday from 6:30 to 8:30 PM or Saturdays from 11 AM to 3 PM. He staffs our hospitality in the Parish Center.

I look forward to your cooperation for the good of the children and families of our parish.

MENSAJE SEMANAL



Hermanos y hermanas, escuchamos un mensaje en el evangelio de este domingo que nos desafía, tal vez, más que cualquier otro dicho de Jesús: "Si alguno viene donde mí, y no odia a su padre, a su madre, a su mujer, a sus hijos, a sus hermanos, a sus hermanas y hasta su propia vida, no puede ser discípulo mío. Él que no lleve su cruz y venga en pos de mí, no puede ser discípulo mío" (Lc 14:26-27). Parece como locura – y como podemos, al mismo tiempo, seguir el mandamiento de amar a todos, junto con este mandamiento para "odiar" a todos? Al menos por apariencias, es una contradicción completa...

Pero es solamente una apariencia. Amor verdadero para nuestro prójimo, y para nosotros mismos, implica un cierto tipo de "odio" – odio para nuestra propia voluntad, nuestras propias proyecciones, planes, visiones, etc., enraizado en el reconocimiento que la voluntad de Dios es infinitamente mejor que la nuestra. Aún cuando conlleva sufrimiento, cruces, y dificultades de muchos tipos, a fin de cuentas, Dios siempre está trabajando para unirnos consigo por el poder del Espíritu Santo.

Este mandamiento desafiante de Jesús, al final, es una invitación para siempre ver nuestras vidas en la luz de la fe. Ver que nuestras cruces, y las cruces de nuestros hermanos y hermanas, son "árboles de la vida," a través de que Dios obra sus milagros en nuestras vidas. Si perdamos nuestras vidas por él, los salvaremos, y poseeremos la plenitud de alegría, ahora y por toda eternidad.
