## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

### Let's Bring Common Sense Back to Hoboken Government

When Hoboken was developing in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the northwest section, where Shop Rite and Academy



Bus, for example, are located, was all marsh land. And the town officials allowed the natural wetlands to remain open since they knew that Hoboken is below sea level and would often flood. These marshes absorbed the overflow of water. 200 years later, we think we can fight Mother Nature and have overbuilt Hoboken to the point where there is no place for the water to go and we have periodic and regular floods especially in those areas where we built on marshland, which is also where we built public housing for the poor. There is no halt in sight so we are planning a quarter billion dollar water wall on the Hudson, which most engineers agree is a boondoggle for consultants and lawyers and entrepreneurs and even crackpots. But that's for another column.

For now, let's look at what we have done. We have so many residents and so many cars so

we punish them by creating regular traffic jams in the hope that they will give up their cars, and being located in between two major tunnels that ain't gonna happen any time soon. We create an inhospitable environment for out-of-town visitors with cars, which depresses our local economy. We have more parks for our small town than needed. So when a major ferry company needs to use the Dry Dock land for ferry repairs, we threaten to take the land by eminent domain, which at the new governor's request has been revoked by the City Council. This problem is at a standstill.

I am grateful to Mary Ondrejka, a parishioner and civic activist, for her leadership on this issue. Mary is filled with common sense and speaks often before the City council meetings. She has her facts and sticks to them because she does her homework. Because of her, I sent a letter to New York Waterways and you can read the reply on p. 6 of this bulletin. Why can't we have a landscaped ferry parcel that allows for open space as well as allow for a major transportation company to meet the needs of thousands of people who use the ferries daily. That would be common sense. This is lacking in Hoboken. We have allowed the town to be highjacked by people who are out of touch with the main stream and force policy changes that impair rather than improve us.

I know some people will disagree and that is fine. We need a healthy debate on the future of Hoboken. Let common sense prevail.

On behalf of the thousands of New Jersey residents who rely on NY Waterway ferries every day and on behalf of the hundreds of dedicated NY Waterway employees, I thank you for your letter to the editor in the Jersey Journal Wednesday.

Your well-reasoned and articulate message truly represents the best interests of your parishioners and of all the people of Hoboken. I and my son, Armand Pohan, the chairman of NY Waterway, have had several discussions with Mayor Ravinder Bhalla, emphasizing to him that we can develop additional public green space on the Union Dry Dock site, while still performing the vital function of maintaining our ferry fleet.

As you note in your letter, trying to seize our property through eminent domain will be a long, costly and contentious process. If this misguided effort is successful, the people of Hoboken will be confronted with a substantial tax bill and our riders will face increased fares.
